

**WALMART DE MÉXICO Y CENTROAMÉRICA REPORTS**  
**JUNE 2016 SALES**

**Wal-Mart de México, S.A.B. de C.V. (BMV: WALMEX)** announces to its shareholders as well as to the public in general that during the month of June 2016, sales amounted to **\$41,240 million pesos**. This figure represents an **11.1%** increase over sales reported in the same month of 2015.

**Mexico Sales**

During **June 2016**, total sales for Mexico increased **7.9%** over sales reported in June 2015. Comp stores sales during the month, meaning all those units in operation for over a year, posted a **6.8%** increase compared to the same month of 2015.

Considering the **five-week period** from **May 28 to July 1, 2016**, as compared to the five-week period ending July 3, 2015, total sales increased **7.9%** and comp store sales increased **6.8%**.

The average ticket at our stores during the month of June experienced a **7.4%** increase in comp units, and the number of transactions had a **0.6%** decrease as compared to the same month of 2015.

## Central America Sales

During June, total sales for Central America, on a constant currency basis, increased **7.5%**, and comp store sales posted an increase of **4.3%**.

## Corporate Social Responsibility

Walmart de México Foundation announced its donation of five thousand boxes of groceries to the Mexican Red Cross to benefit approximately 25 thousand people with basic food supplies and staple items. The boxes will be sent and distributed among those regions that could be impacted by any disastrous meteorological phenomena during this hurricane season.

During the celebration of the World Arbor Day, on June 28, Walmart de México y Centroamérica announced that from 2012 to 2015, Walmart de México Foundation planted over 194,900 trees and ornamental plants in woods, parks, gardens and green areas in schools throughout the country.
